The Strategic Cereal Farm East will have four trials for harvest 2021:

- Work package 1: Managed lower inputs
- Work package 2: Cover crops
- Work package 3: Flower strips
- · Work package 4: Marginal land

Your application should address each work package separately, and you should provide detailed costs of each assessment on a work package basis.




Figure 1 Trial locations at Strategic Cereal Farm East






Figure 2 Deep electrical conductivity (0-120 cm) measured in 2017 at Strategic Cereal Farm East






Figure 3 Shallow electrical conductivity (0 - 40 cm) measured in 2017 at Strategic Cereal Farm East
