## Eco Working Group 2023 achievements

- 10 meetings since formation in March 2023.
- Identified and prioritised a wide range of challenges for quantifying and communicating the environmental impacts of agri-food organisations and products.
- Reviewed the existing work across external organisations working on these challenges.
- Agreed recommendations to Defra for further policy development, including:
  - GHG Protocol Scope 3 standard should be the minimum baseline for company reporting.
  - To support the development of **WRAP's reporting protocols** V2, which will provide more specific guidance on scope 3 reporting for the food and drink sector.
  - To facilitate and support primary data collection in parallel with improving the quality and representativeness of secondary data.
  - To ensure eco-labels accurately communicate environmental impact data to consumers and are future-proofed and adaptable as the science develops.
- Contributed to developing a paper summarising Eco Data workstream progress to date and setting out next steps, due to be published in early 2024.
- Meetings will continue in 2024, with a focus on priorities set out in this paper.
