






2019 Exports Up & Imports Down






45,000 fewer tonnes of beef in the Canadian market so far in 2019


Where is Canada Beef Going?




REMOVING BARRIERS CREATES VALUE



76% of Canadian Beef Exports Go to NAFTA Partners






CUSMA/AKANAFTA 2.0

Signed Nov 30, 2018

Needs to be approved by the three legislatures

- Has been ratified by Mexico
- Canada has committed to moving in step with the US
- Canadian election yesterday
- US Administration still negotiating with Congress

We are OK with whatever pace occurs **IF** the original NAFTA remains in place





First six months of 2019 to China triple same period in 2018


Still only 7% of Cdn beef exports

Two CPTPP tariff cuts since last December


Catch up to Australia

EUROPE - CETA

CETA has been in effect since Sept 21, 2017

- 65,000 tonnes of duty-free access for Canadian beef to EU
- Unlimited duty-free access for EU beef to Canada

In 2019:

Canada has shipped: *1,008 tonnes beef to EU (730 to the UK)

*1,314 tonnes pork to EU (172 to the UK)

EU has shipped: * 4,296 tonnes beef to Canada (1,739 from UK)

*14,253 tonnes pork to Canada (222 from UK)
