AHDB Harvest Results service to return for 2019

An indication of how cereal and winter oilseed rape varieties have performed during the 2018/19 growing season will be revealed by the AHDB Harvest Results service.

Based on validated results from Recommended Lists (RL) variety trial sites, the service provides access to information on yield, grain quality and agronomic features, as well as how key disease have affected varieties.

Winter barley results are the first to roll off the plot combines and arrive about mid-July.

Regular email updates are provided right through the harvest period. Issued most Mondays, the emails include access to analysis by variety selection experts.

The next edition of the AHDB Recommended Lists (2020/21) will be launched online in December.

AHDB Recommended Lists (RL) trials test variety performance under optimum conditions. Care should be taken when making comparisons with commercial yields. Results from individual trial sites should not be used to make conclusions on variety performance. The RL publications are based on information from trials across the UK over several seasons. As more information becomes available from the current harvest, this will contribute to the over-trials averages – which comprise four years for oilseeds and five years for cereals. These averages provide better information for comparison between varieties. Performance variation is not the responsibility of AHDB. Since the focus is to test new varieties, not all RL varieties are presented. Yields for well-established varieties are published at <u>ahdb.org.uk/rl</u>
