



AHDB Aphid News

Suction-trap period 05 August – 11 August 2019

General

- This bulletin week, above average rainfall continues to hamper the harvest. The total number of reported aphids has decreased to 54% of those recorded last week.
- Total cereal aphid numbers have also decreased to 56% of last week. Hotspots for bird cherry-oat aphids remain across Scottish sites, however; the risk to crops is passing for this season.
- Only two peach-potato aphids were recorded from Starcross this week.
- No potato aphids were recorded this week.
- Only a single cabbage aphid was found at Silwood Park this week.
- No currant-lettuce aphids were recorded this week.
- Only a single willow-carrot aphid was found at Gogarbank this week.
- A single pea aphid was recorded this week from York. The risk to crops is passing for this season.
- No black bean aphids were recorded this week. The threshold for black bean aphid in field and broad beans is 10% colonisation. A lower threshold of 5% infested is advised to prevent virus transmission.


Monitoring vulnerable crops is still advised.

Suction-trap locations

AHDB Aphid News is based on information on aphid species and numbers from the Rothamsted Research/SASA suction-trap (ST) network. The traps are located at:

Inverness (Iv), Dundee (D), Gogarbank (G), Ayr (Ay), Newcastle (N), Preston (P), York (Y), Kirton (K), Broom's Barn (BB), Wellesbourne (We), Hereford (H), Rothamsted Tower (RT), Writtle (Wr), Silwood Park (SP), East Malling* (EM) and Starcross (SX).

^{*} The East Malling (EM) trap will start operating during 2019.
