


## **HUMAN AND INDUSTRIAL USAGE**

#### **KEY POINTS**

- In June 2019, the UK milling industry<sup>(1)</sup> used 517.8 thousand tonnes of wheat, 16.0% lower year on year. For the 2018/19 season, wheat usage totalled 6.1 million tonnes, 11.0% lower than in 2017/18.
- In 2018/19 the UK milling industry<sup>(1)</sup> used 5.1 million tonnes of home grown wheat, down 13.2% compared to 2017/18. Imported wheat usage increased by 1.2%, to 1.0 million tonnes.
- UK brewers, maltsters, and distillers used 167.1 thousand tonnes of barley in June 2019, a 12.8% increase on the year. Over the full season<sup>(3)</sup>,1.4% more barley was used compared with 2017/18, at 1.9 million tonnes. In 2018/19 UK brewers, maltsters and distillers used 722.2 thousand tonnes of wheat, 9.0% less than in 2017/18.
- For the 2018/19 crop year, the amount of oats milled in the UK was relatively unchanged (-0.1%) on the 2017/18 season, at 536.0 thousand tonnes.
