

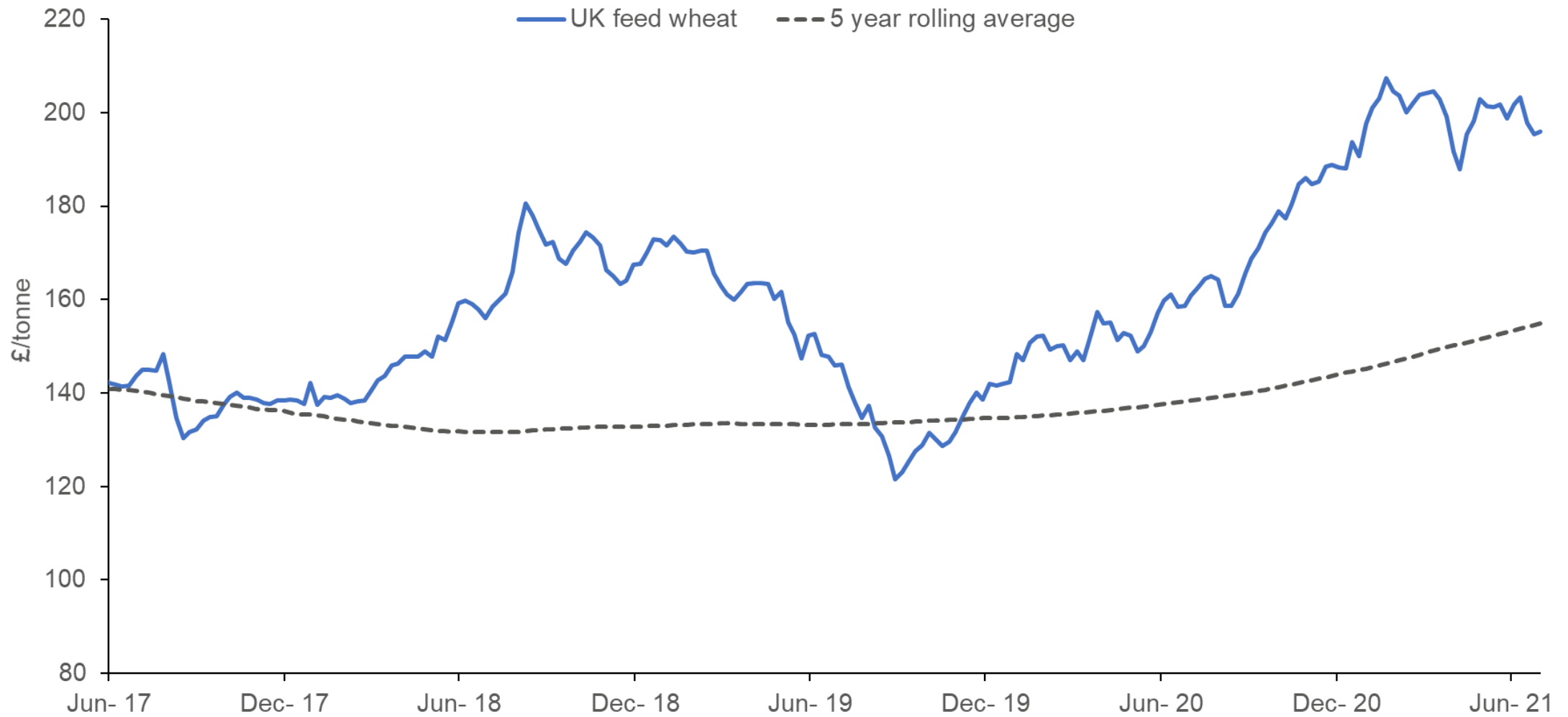

Feed wheat: UK average ex-farm price



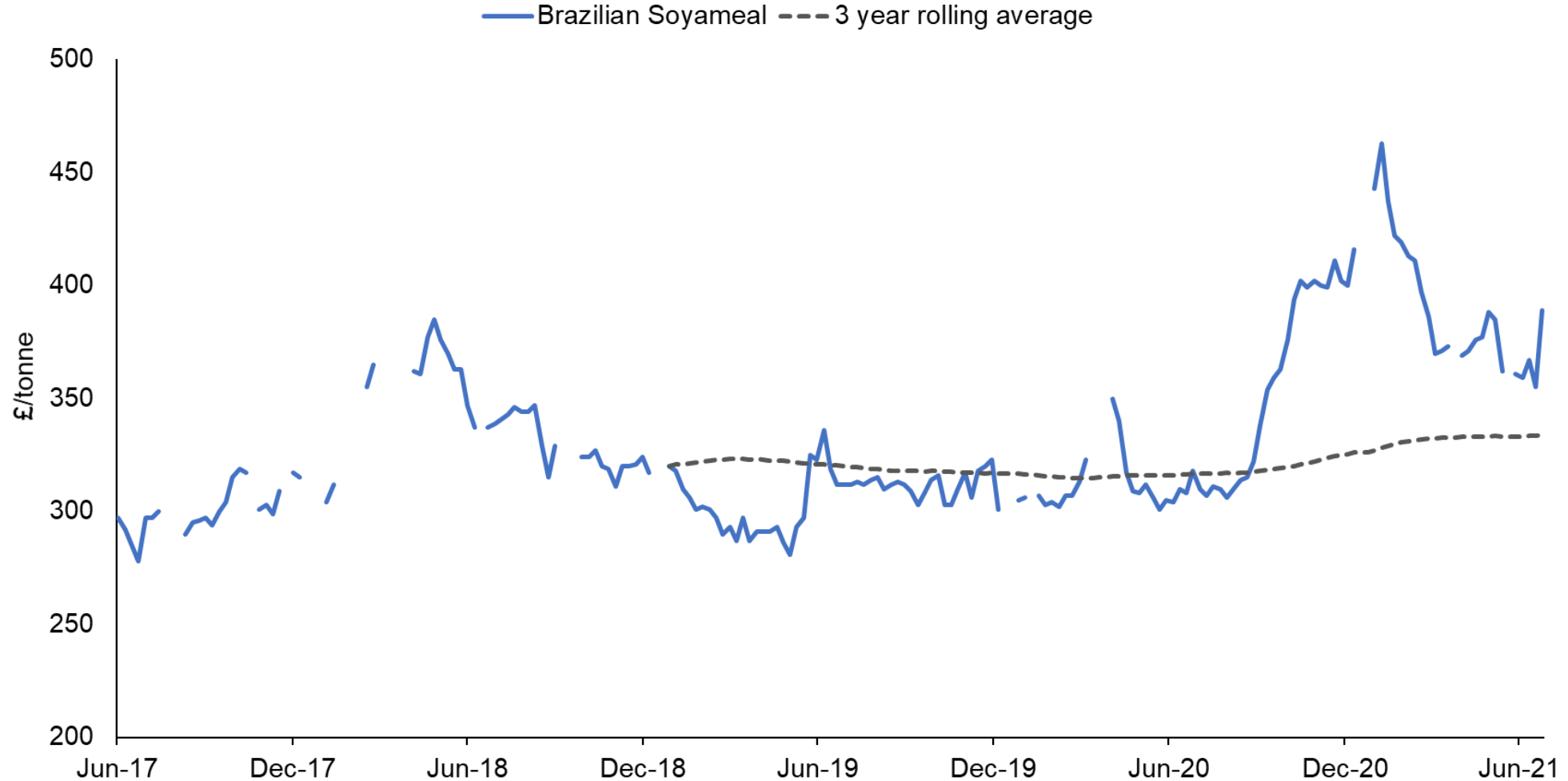
Oilseed Rape: Average price delivered to Erith

Brazilian Soyameal (48%): Average price ex-store



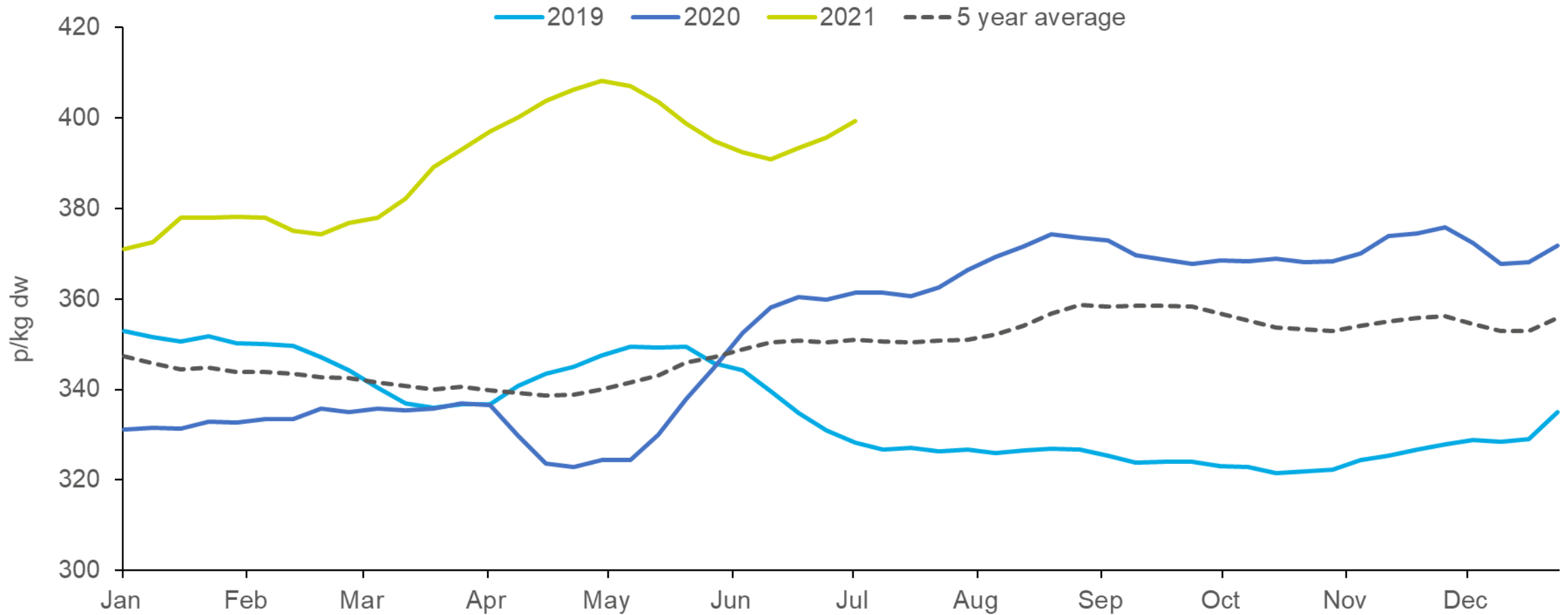
Potatoes: GB overall & free-buy WAPS prices

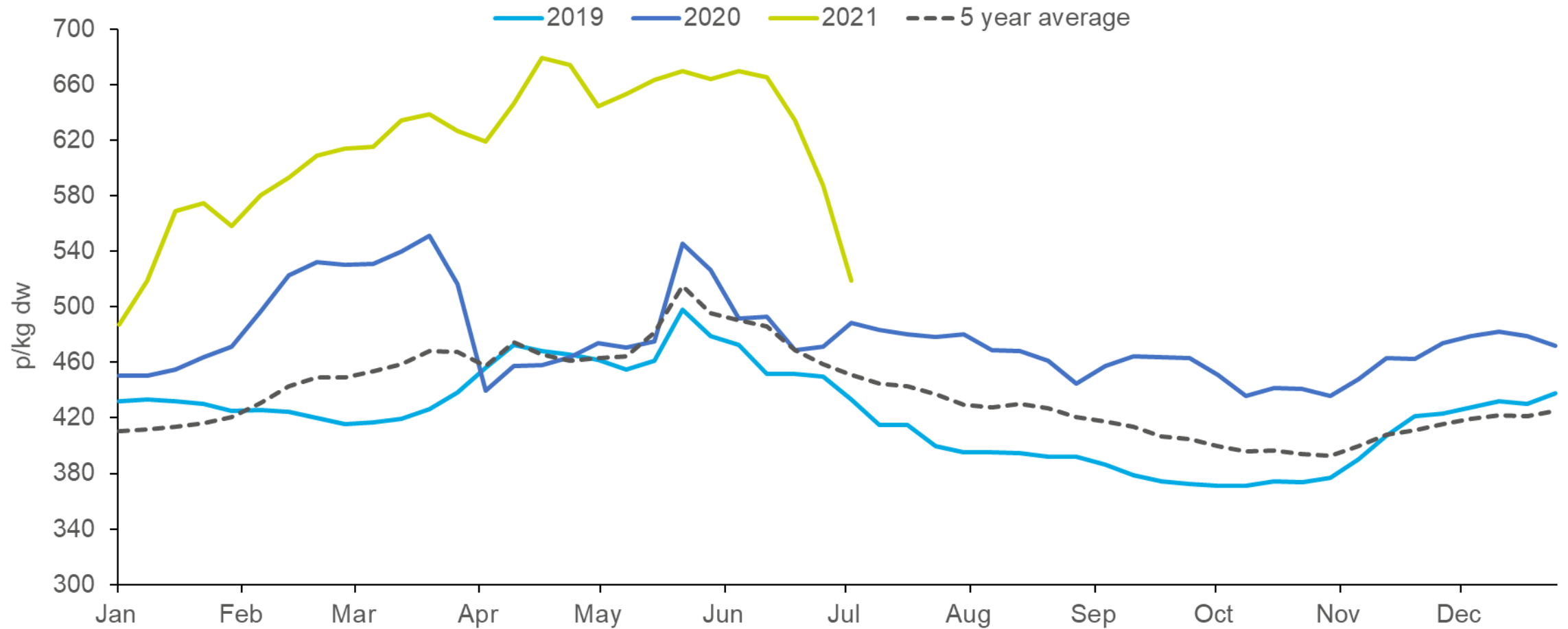

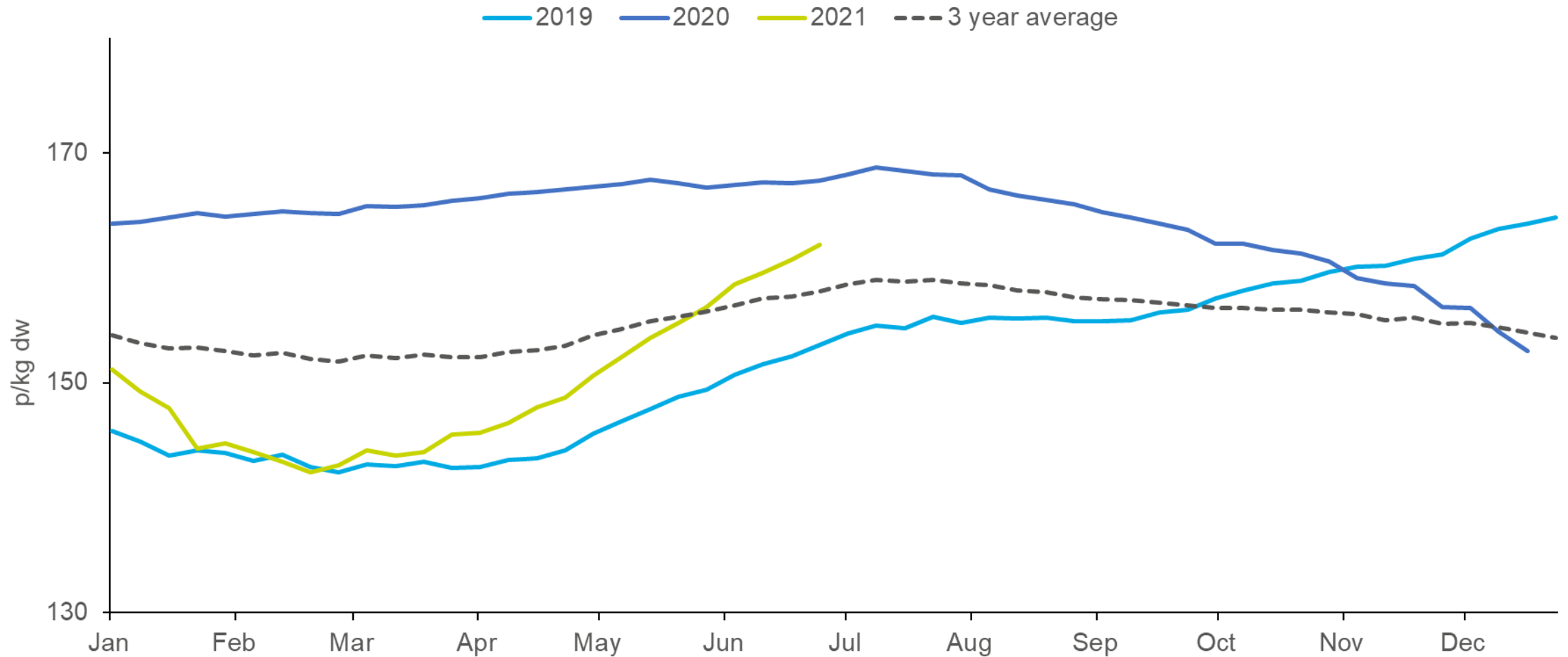
Sheep: GB deadweight lamb SQQ price



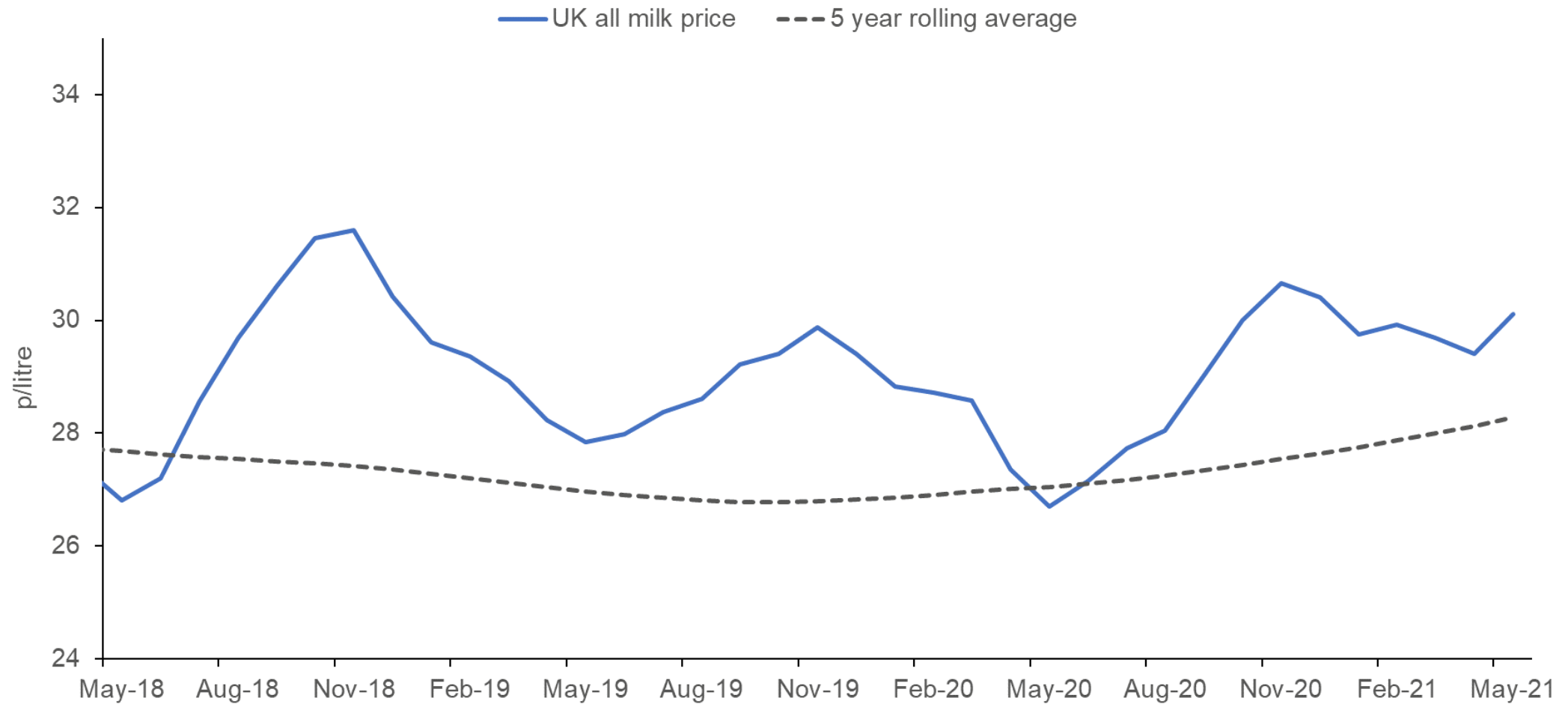

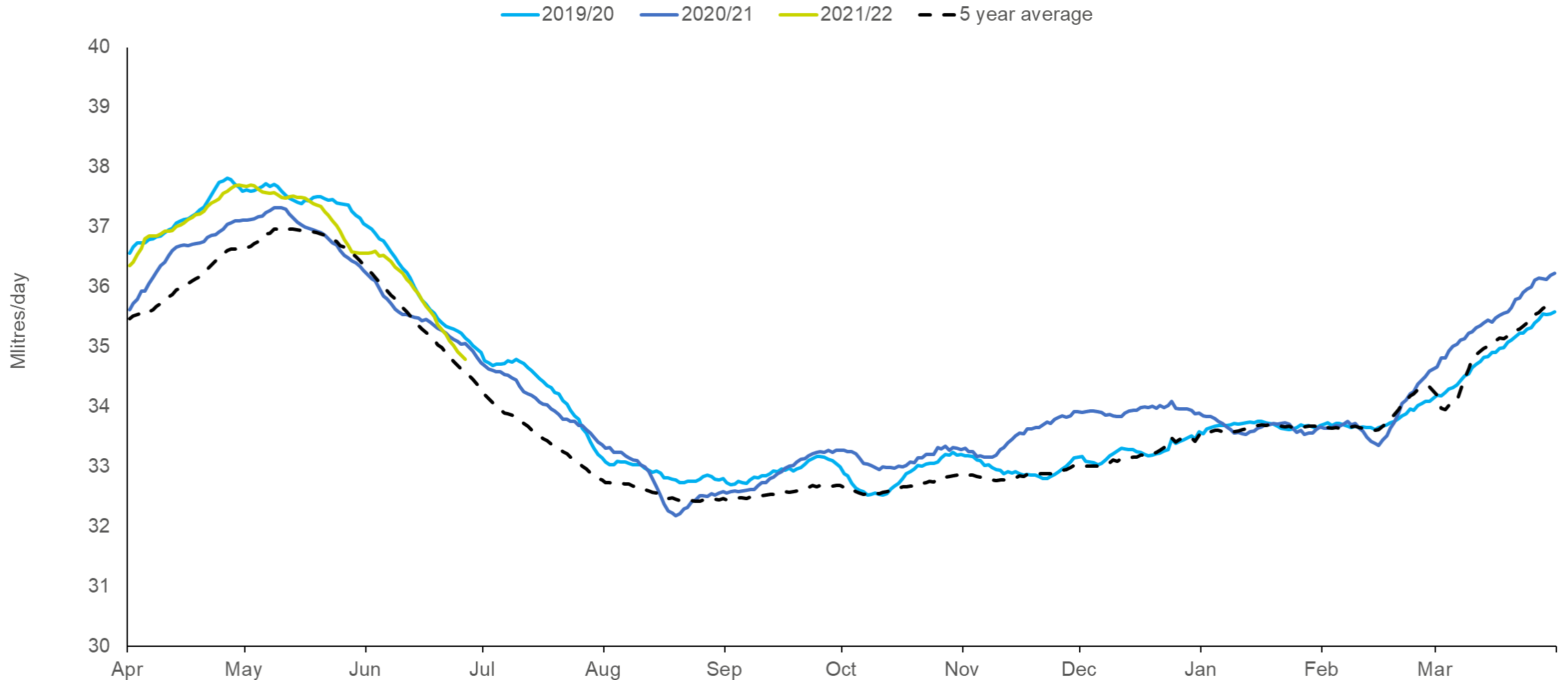
Pigs: GB deadweight All Pig Price (EU spec)



Milk: UK 'all milk' farmgate price



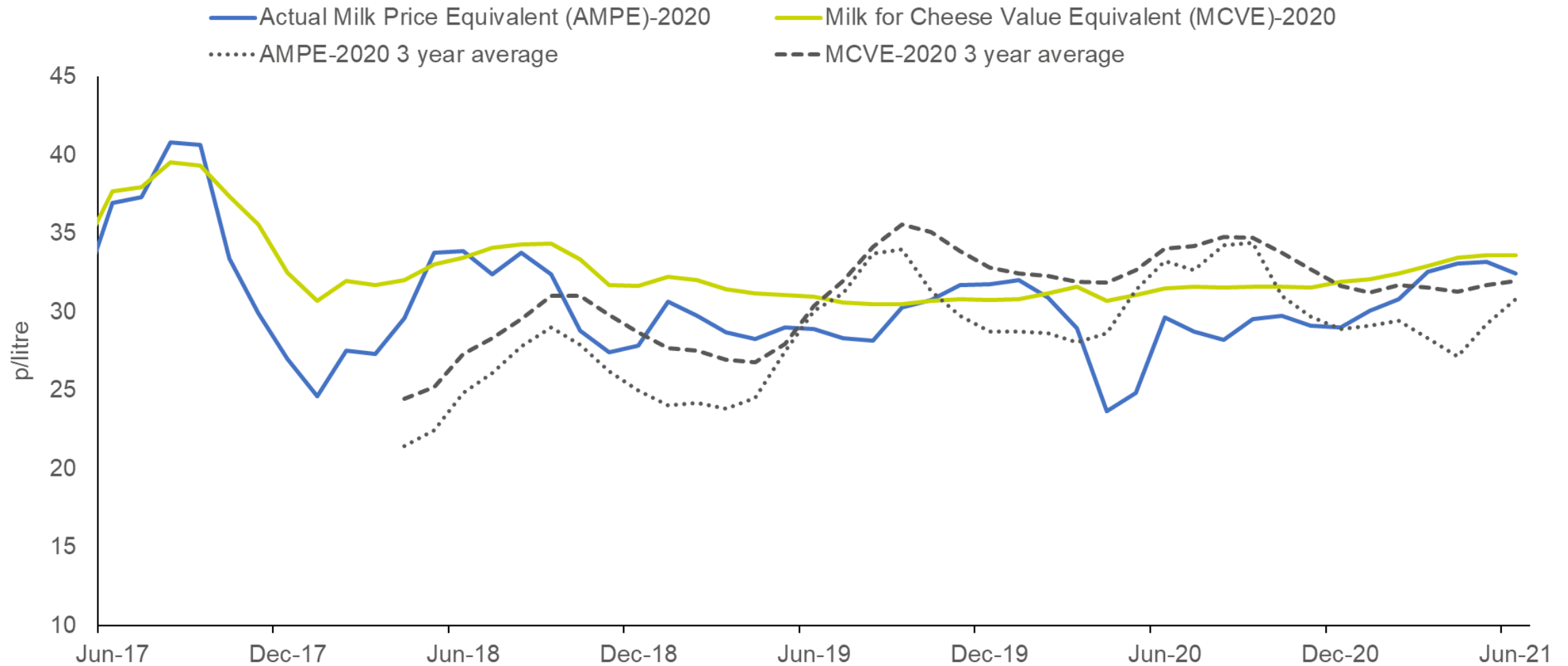
Daily milk deliveries: GB 7 day rolling average



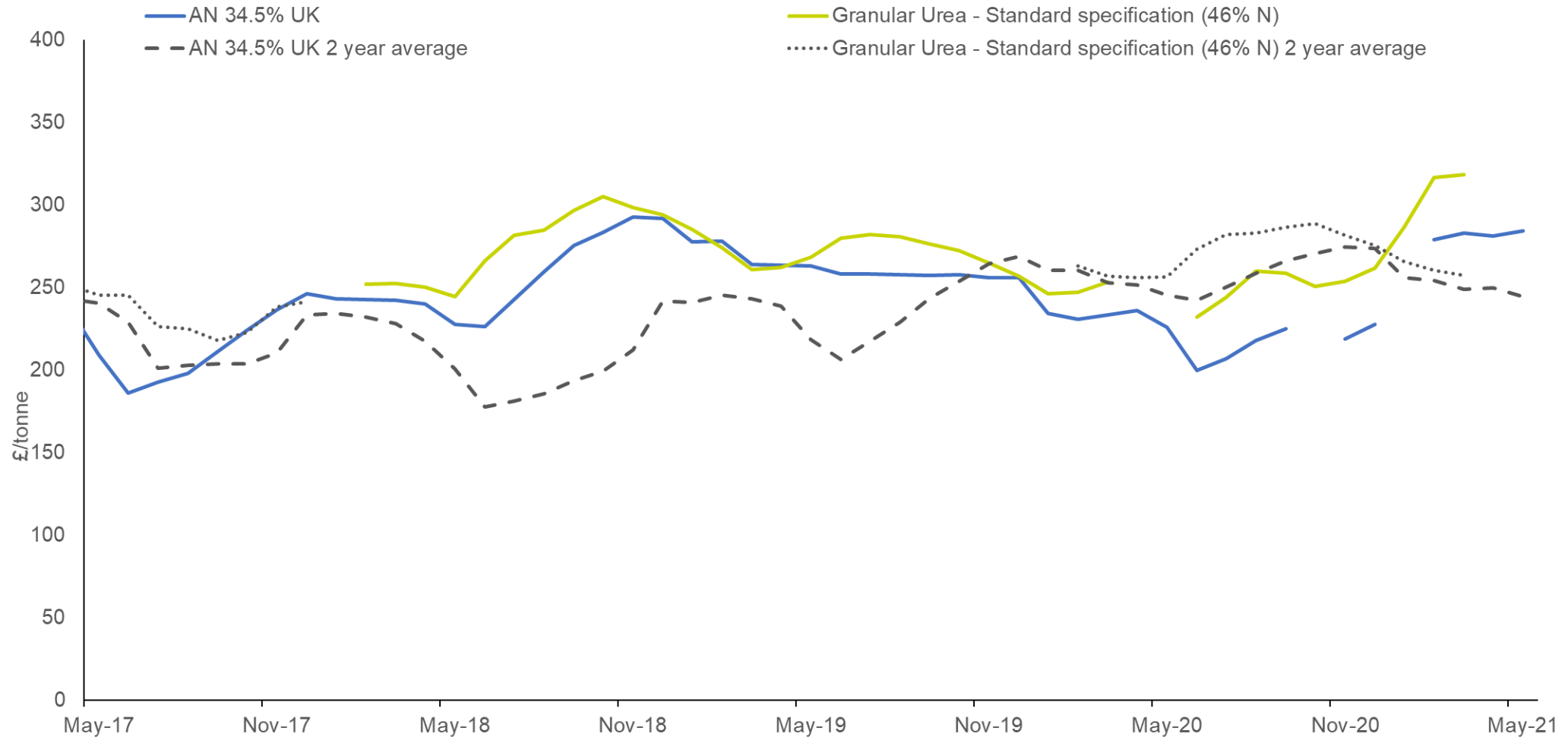
