


A First World Problem

- Netherlands Temporary non EU Work Visa
- Poland 500k seasonal workers (non-EU)
- USA 240k seasonal workers, 450K proposed
- Australia, NZ, South Korea seasonal schemes




Inflection punnet Britain, planted area, hectares, 2004=100







- Non-EU: Moldova, Ukraine, Russia
- Concordia & Proforce
- NFU ask of government:
 - 10,000 permits for 2019
 - Cap on Fee



- EU workers free to enter
- Right to remain application after 3 months: ID, security & criminality check. Fee TBC
- NFU asks:
 - Extend to 6-12 months
 - -Clear, positive comms





Future Immigration - White Paper

- Issues:
 - -"Skilled" and £30k+
 - -12 month in /12 month out
- Responded to MAC consultation -Shortage Occupation List



Industry Ambition

- Consumer Trends: Health, plant-based, vegan
- Growth: massive opportunity
- People: Robotics, Al, Automation will take out lowest skilled jobs in 5-10 years but we will still need people
