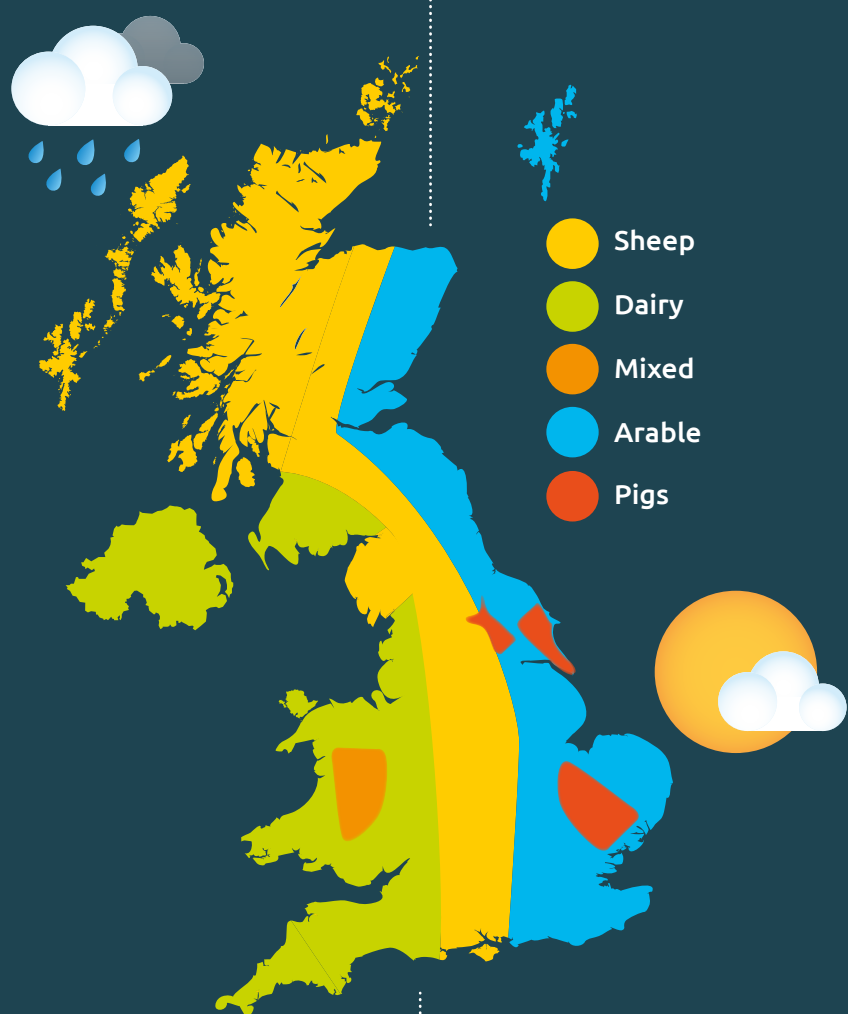

Climate & farming are closely related

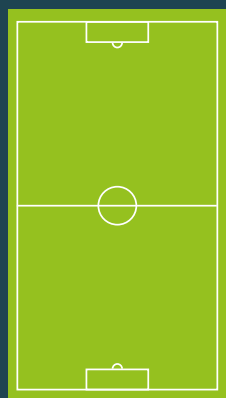


Mainly wet and one of the best parts of the world to grow grass

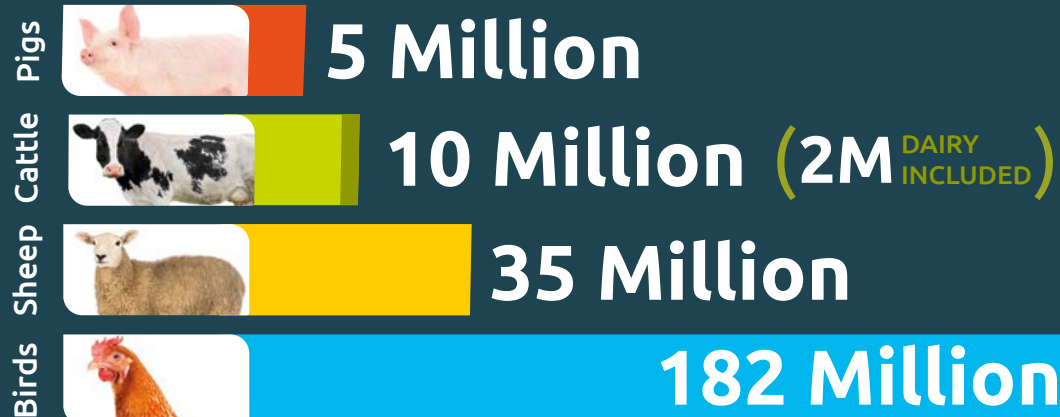

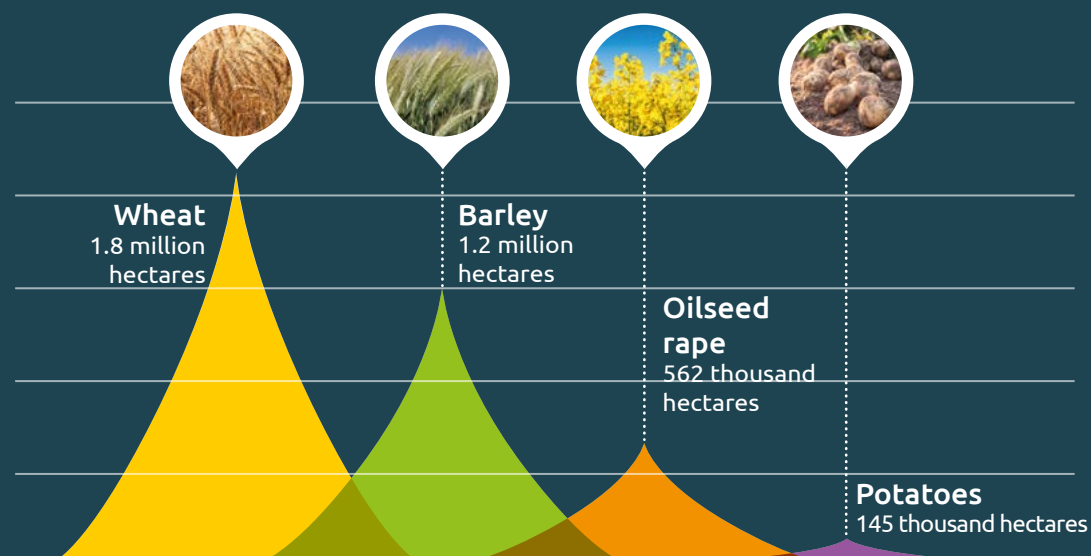
